On April 2, 2020, the Executive Board of Plumbers & Pipefitters Local Union No. 562 passed a resolution to establish a COVID-19 Assistance Program to assist members negatively impacted by the COVID-19 Pandemic.

On October 14, 2020, the following changes were made to adjust the program for November and December 2020.

How to receive a full Assistance Benefit:

- 1. You must be a member in good standing
- 2. You must be on the Out of Work List (OOWL)
- 3. It is your responsibility to call in the week you are affected. Please note you must call in within the month you are laid off. Once a new month starts NO checks will be given for previous months.

Things that will keep you from receiving a full Assistance Benefit:

- 1. You were fired
- 2. You turned down work
- 3. You quit a job
- 4. You are not a member of Plumbers and Pipefitters Local 562

These are your responsibilities:

- 1. Current with your UA Dues
- 2. Union office has your most current address
- 3. Contact Abbie Feldt in the Union Office to ensure your spot on the Assistance list
